HullaBOWLoo Returns to Chattanooga Area Food Bank Warehouse *Theme of Welcome Home reflects return to original site after five years*

CHATTANOOGA, Tenn. – On April 27, 2019, the Chattanooga Area Food Bank (the Food Bank) will *Welcome Home* its signature fundraiser, **HullaBOWLoo**, presented by Adman Electric. This year's event will be hosted at the Food Bank's 40,000-square-foot warehouse at 2009 Curtain Pole Road in Chattanooga from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. The evening will feature a live performance from Michel Jons Band, a silent auction of premium items, and food and beverage tastings from local restaurants and businesses. A limited number of tickets are available for the VIP garden party from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the Evelyn Davenport Navarre Teaching Garden pavilion featuring tastings from Il Primo and Chattanooga Whiskey.
